There are inevitable environmental impacts of touring and producing live shows. By adhering to Paradigm's Green Rider, we seek to lessen waste, support positive social impacts, reduce single use plastic and ensure a sustainable future for the environment.

### 1. AVOID SINGLE USE PLASTICS

Please no single use plastics, including water bottles, cups, polystyrene, straws or stirrers, bags, or needless packing. Provide portable water for refills, reusable tableware (i.e. plates, forks, knives, cups) and avoid food with excessive packaging. No single use condiment packaging. Provide easy access to water refill station with sturdy re-usable cups & bottles for use on stage.

### 2. PROVIDE CLEARLY LABELLED RECYCLING CONTAINERS

Please provide clearly labelled recycling and compost bins for easy separation.

# 3. SUSTAINABLY SOURCED, SEASONAL FOOD

Please ensure any fruit, salad, or vegetables are locally and seasonally sourced to reduce food mileage and support local producers. If available, Certified Organic food is also preferred to minimise environmentally harmful farming practices.

## 4. SUSTAINABLE DIETARY OPTIONS

#### a. VFGANS

Please ensure no meat, dairy, or animal products are provided, including honey.

### b. NON-VEGANS

Any meat, fish or dairy products provided must be traceable and certified as local, organic, or otherwise sustainably sourced.

### 5. NO PALM OIL PRODUCTS

Please avoid products with palm oil, unless proven from ethical sources.

### 6. STRICTLY ONLY FAIR-TRADE

Please ensure all tea, coffee, sugar, and chocolate are certified as Fair Trade or Rainforest Alliance.

# 7. SALVAGE ANY LEFTOVER EDIBLE FOOD

Please avoid any leftovers by ensuring provisions match the need. Make efforts to safely collect and redistribute any surplus edible food.



### 8. CHECK WITH TOUR MANAGER BEFORE FULFILLING RIDER

The artist rider may have changed since the time of show booking, and therefore certain items may no longer be required. Please check with the tour manager prior to final supply purchase to avoid unnecessary waste.

### 9. ETHICALLY SOURCED AND REUSABLE TOWELS

Please ensure any towels provided are clean and if newly purchased, sourced from ethical fibres, such as organic cotton. These towels are more expensive than cheap alternatives but will last longer and can (and should) be reused.

## 10. UNCESSARY PRINTING & PAPER PRODUCTS

Please avoid any unnecessary printing and if essential, only use certified ethically sourced or recycled paper. This also applies to any toilet paper, paper towels, and napkins. Any access passes should be recyclable and made from sustainable sources.

# 11. LOCAL ACCOMMODATIONS

If you are booking hotel accommodations, please choose a hotel as close to the venue as possible to minimize transportation to and from the show. Please confirm this prior to booking as there may be instances where it is more efficient to book closer to the airport or between locations, etc. Give preference to hotels with any environmental credentials or certification.
